Dear Sir,

I shall be thankful if you will kindly permit me some space in your valuable journal to state the following facts regarding Major Birrel-Gray, the Resident of the Colony, father, (Haba) as he was generally called when he was stationed here as Acting Resident of the Province, through his generosity and kindness towards Egba people. I have read with much interest your issue *Eko Akete* of the 6th instant, your letter to the Resident Major Birrel-Gray, and his reply invited you personally to his office when interview began between you and the Resident regarding the meeting he had with the Lagos White Cap Chiefs on Friday the 23rd of May 1925, about their non-appearance in seeing the Governor off on the 8th May 1925. During this meeting Major Birrel-Gray, Resident of the Colony according to the publication of the *Weekly Record* of May 18-23 ultimo used many insulting and abusive terms to all the Lagos White Cap Chiefs, excepting one who has obeyed the Government order by bidn his last farewell to Sir Hugh Clifford on the occasion of his final departure from Nigeria shore on the 8th of May 1925. As an Editor, you have acted very well indeed for the way you arrange your interview with the Resident of the Colony, on the 2nd instant.

According to each question put before him by you and his reply to each question moved me to undertake the task of writing you to-day about this good Resident and to tell you very little of what I know about him when he was here with us as Acting Resident of the Province.

Major Birrel-Gray now a Resident of the Colony of Lagos, is a man of good conduct, quiet, patient, kind and sympathetic to many people when he was staying in our midst here (Abeokuta) in so much that majority of people in Abeokuta gave him the name of Father (Haba) according to his kindness towards the people of Abeokuta. Among

the Resident we have been having at Abeokuta since the advent of the British Protection in Abeokuta. Major Birrel-Gray has taken the lead. If you have any grievance and went to him he will assist the party either him or her, to the last point, he seeks the interest of all in town. If you are without any job and you went to him he is ready to give you a helping hand at once. His removal from Abeokuta has caused many regrets among the majority of people in the town of Abeokuta and large number of people strongly felt his departure from the town. Several petitions were sent to the Governor by the Alake and Council that he may kindly allow Major Birrel-Gray to remain with us at Abeokuta, but the letter or petition did not meet with success to the Egba Administration.

Regarding your question No. 7 to the Resident in your issue of the 6th instant about his past employment at Ilorin which was published by the *Weekly Record* of 18-23 that when he, Major Birrel-Gray was working at Ilorin the natives of that place used to call him Ata.

In the year 1912 when I was under the Nigerian Railways at Ilorin, one Mr. E. C. Duff was then the Resident of the Province, and every native at Ilorin called him Ata up till the time, I left the place on transfer further up the North. Thanking you, Mr. Editor for space allowed.
