 Governor Memorial Hall, Dr. John Kemble, in answer to a
 question by Mr. J. Akpan Oshun, explained that the
 challenges had passed through that Mr. Mearns's name
 should not be included in the Committee because he is
 a permanent foe of the Government.

WHAT WE SAY.

But we are in a position to assert that the Local Adminis-
 tration has the greatest regard for the ability, capability and
 local influence of Mr. Mearns as the following correspon-
 dence amply testifies.

His Honor the Lt. Governor issued on the 27th Septem-
 ber 1914, the following circular letter on the subject of the
 Yaba acquisition to a few gentlemen including the Hon. the
 First Lagos Member —

Dear Sir,

In view of the Acquisition Notice contained in the
Magazine of the East-Advertiser of September 20, covering
 a large area of land in the direction of Yaba, I would be
 glad if you could make it convenient to attend a meeting at
 my house at 10.30 a.m. on Wednesday next, October 1,
 when I propose to put before you the proposals of the
 Government, in connection with this acquisition so that there
 may be no mis-conception with regard to them, and at the
 same time ask for your criticism and advice.

2. I have mentioned the invitations to the meeting to the
 Honourable Members for Lagos on the Legislative Council,
 the Elected Members of the Town Council, and the Editors
 of the principal Newspapers published in Lagos. I quite
 realize that this may exclude a number of prominent
 citizens who would also wish to be kept informed of the
 situation, and I would welcome the presence of any gentle-
 man you might wish to bring with you to the meeting, and
 would be glad to know, when you acknowledge this invita-
 tion, the name of the gentleman you propose to bring.

In his reply, the Hon. Mr. Strangely endorsed the follow-
 ing paragraph on the 27th September —

"With regard to the extension of your Honour's
 invitation under paragraph 2 of your Honour's letter under
 reply, I propose to bring with me to the meeting, in view of
 the importance of the subject as touching the Land Ques-
 tion, Mr. Herbert Macaulay, Civil Engineer and Licensed
 Surveyor, or Kirien Hall, lawyer, subject to your Honour's
 approval, or in the alternative, Mr. J. Huggan Boinjima,
 Civil Engineer and Licensed Surveyor."

His Honor, Lt. Col. Moorhouse, C.M.G., D.S.O., promptly
 replied on the same date as follows:—

"By all means bring Mr. Macaulay on Wednesday morn-
 ing. My object in continuing my original invitation to the

Members of the Legislative Council, the elected Members of
 the Town Council, and the members of the local Press, and
 asking each of them to bring another gentleman, was
 prompted partly by want of space and partly because I felt
 that those invited would be in a better position to say who
 were most keenly interested in the scheme than I could
 possibly be myself.

I should be glad to see Mr. Kemble, and if he were no
 longer interested by anyone else, please bring them also.

Eko Akete's First Annual Dinner at Bonanza Hotel.

J. H. DOHERTY ESQ., PRINCIPAL GUEST.

Thursday the 9th inst. will go down in history as a Red Letter Day in the annals of the journalistic world of Nigeria; for it was the evening of that day that the First Annual Dinner of this paper took place in the Bonanza Hotel—the occasion standing as a record-breaker being the first annual dinner ever held by any Newspaper in Nigeria.

Promptly at 8.30 p.m. ticket holders began to file in the precincts of the great hotel and at about 9 o'clock there was quite a fairly large gathering. A few minutes after a lady and the gentlemen present had taken their seats the news that Mr. J. H. Doherty, the Principal Guest for the evening, would be unable to attend owing to a betwement that afternoon was received with sympathy. Messrs. Duro, Thomas and L. O. Thompson (Dispenser) were elected Chairman and Sub-Chairman respectively. At 9.5 the proceedings of the evening were opened by the Rev. A. A. Puddicombe who said the grace.

The Chairman's Opening Speech followed. It is regrettable that owing to a Concert which was going on at the first floor and other meetings at the adjoining apartments of the hotel, the playing on the piano, and gramophone, not to say anything of the intermittent shouts of applause, interfered a great deal with the facility of hearing and recording the various speeches of the evening.

The Chairman, in his opening speech paid a glowing tribute to the Editor of *Eko Akete* and referred to the gathering of that evening as unique in Nigeria journalistic history.

This was followed by Refreshments. After travelling through the items of the Menu (all credit to Mr. Rahm the Manager of the hotel) the toast of the King was heartily drunk to.

The toast of The West African Press was ably proposed by Mr. Oluyele Bright. The efforts of our journalists, he thought, are not receiving due appreciation from the public to whose interest and welfare these efforts are directed. The *Eko Akete*, he is sure, is being read by more than two thousand people weekly. To-night looking round him he found not more than 30 people. Where are the remaining 1,970 readers? This toast was responded to by Mr. L. O. Thompson who supported the sentiments expressed by Mr. Bright.

The toast of the Editor *Eko Akete* was next proposed by Mr. B. Ade Mumoney. He became acquainted with Mr. Adeoye Desiga, popularly called "The Professor" on account of his numerous literary productions, as recently a 8 years ago (laughter). Mr. Desiga's first editorial effort dated as far back as 1906 when he started *The Lagos Astrological Mercury*—a paper hand-written and read by a small circle of people. In 1910 he edited *The New Age Herald*; in 1913, *The Herald-Alore*—a bilingual and to-day we have the *Eko Akete* at the instance of which we are all assembled here this evening.

In religious circles he is as active as in the journalistic field—This is borne out by the fact that he occupies no less an office in his Church than that of the Superintendent of the Lagos Mission (hear, hear).

The toast was responded to by Professor A. Denica the Editor of this paper. He is very thankful to Mr. Mumoney for the high compliments paid him. Whatever he has been able to do in his little way has been done through the selfless assistance of the various contributors to the paper. A paper without a qualified staff of writers will go to the dogs, and he thanked God he is able to boast of first class writers. He thanked all those present for sparing the time to come and participate in the function of the evening. It is an honour done to him—it is an honour done not only to him but to the country—nay, it is an honour done not only to the country but the whole Negro race—(applause).

This was followed by the Chairman's closing speech. He appealed to all those present to put their good wishes to practice—i.e.—to subscribe to the *Eko Akete* which is already having the largest circulation of all the local periodicals and also to induce their friends to do so.

Among those present were Messrs Olufemi Blaize, A. Taninowo Ariari, D. Ayo Bright, J. T. Bright, S. A. Johnson, Alfred Williams, N. A. Solade, A. F. Breck Akibogun, Miss Eburn Williams, and a host of others.

The proceedings were brought to a close with the singing of God Save The King!!!

So your Committee have found it necessary to thwart the efforts of the Hoos. The First and The Second Lagos Member, and those of Mr. B. C. Vaughan in the praise-worthy and laudable attempt to bridge the gulf of misunderstanding which unfortunately exists between your Committee and a prominent member of this community, by the former's blank refusal to meet with this particular member, that is to say, Mr. Herbert Macaulay C.F. in order to find a *modus vivendi* by which to work hand-in-hand in the country's interest, particularly at a time such as this, when steps are being vigorously taken to present a united front in giving The Ambassador of The Empire, a right royal welcome on his advent to these shores in April next.

Again, at a meeting held as recently as on Saturday last at the Glover Memorial Hall, in your reply by a question put by one of your party that is, Mr. J. Akivemi Osobodi, *ancut* the above affair, you are reported to have said that why objection was taken to Mr. Herbert Macaulay's name being eventually included in the prospective Coalition Committee, is that that gentleman is a permanent foe of the Government—whatever this may mean! But you will doubtless agree with me on your reading the extract from a letter sent as a reply by no less a personage than His Honour the Lieut-Governor (S.P.) to The Hon. J. Egerton Shyngle published elsewhere in this issue, that that reply *UPPS A DIRECT LIE* to your ejaculatory remarks—Shame!! to borrow a biblical terminology, would your committee curse whom the Lord does not curse? *Allons donc!*

It is to me a matter of regret to observe that consciously or unconsciously, some members of your committee are actually living up to the tradition of the unenviable epithet fastened on their necks, Goodness knows who? Indeed one of your members at one time in The Honourable Board of our Legislative Council had the brazen effrontery to inform the "House" in one of its sittings that he is glad to be one of the "*Contemptibles*" or words to that effect.

On the face of this shameful admission, is it any wonder to see that the community has scant regard, if any at all, for the members of your committee of such frame of mind.

Again, did any Secretary of State for the Colonies at any time have occasion to inflict so pitiless a lashing on Mr. Herbert Macaulay the seeming *déle noire* of your party, against any future attempt in forwarding that anti-social personality at 10, Downing Street, a Telegram or Petition which, in the opinion of that functionary, is nothing short of a "sarcily veiled threat of seditious agitation" as was certainly the case with one of your number some years ago.

Your request to inform you that we are quite prepared
to co-operate with you, as when we are invited to do so, is
gratified that the names were not put in the meeting,
held at the "Orange Committee" for the purpose for
which you are now writing, be unavailing; and that the
number be reduced to eight, either eight and that Messrs.
Baker, Mearns, G. E. and Akuru, Amosabahun shall
not be included in the eight.

It is considered necessary to limit the number to eight as
our sub-committee consists at present of eight members
who have already taken steps in the matter and have seen
fit to elect the Government.

The names of the Sub-Committee referred to are—The
Hon. K. J. A. O. H. S. H. Pearce, Dr. O. O. Osho, Messrs
P. I. C. Thomas, C. J. D. B. Ocha, A. Akkija, E. S. Iboh
and myself.

If the matter with your approval it is proposed that
the meeting shall take place in one of the Committee Rooms of
the Federal Memorial Hall at 5.30 p.m. on Wednesday the
17th instant.
