DADA ADESHIGBIN OF BLESSED MEMORY

An Oration was delivered by Prof. Deniga at the High
Hall on the late Dada Adeshigbin the 3rd instant at 8.15 p.m.

Mr. Deniga gave a resume of the life of the deceased with
characteristic lucidity.

Dada Adeshigbin was born at Owu in the year 1865.

Hardly anything is known of his early life except that he
was educated at the Breadfruit School, Lagos and later on he
was apprenticed to a famous tailor of those days who was
very strict with his business, a disciplinarian of a business
man. He adopted the motto "Business before pleasure"
after he became free from apprenticeship. He was the sole
agent of the "Singer" Sewing Machines, and so conscientiously
did he do his duty that till the time of his decease
he was sole agent of the "Singer" proprietor in America.
He was an ever-ready man in all charitable works that he
made nothing of the most strenuous exertions even in
Church matters. He would undertake a tour throughout
the northern parts of Nigeria where the interest of the
Church is concerned. He gave liberally. He worked
diligently, faithfully, unstintedly. He would do many
things that pertain to his business, free of charge, without
ostentation. He obeyed his Saviour's injunction, "When
thou givest thy alms, let not thy left hand know what thy
right hand doeth," to the last breath.

He was a peculiarly reserved man of sterling honesty
and great kindness.

He was personally known to writer and by no means a
stranger to the community. He was one of the principal
founders of African Bethel Church. At the time of his
death, there was a partial eclipse of the moon at 11 p.m., on
February 8. "Seest thou a man diligent in his business?
He shall stand before kings." Mr. Adeshigbin was diligent
all through.

Mr. Adeshigbin's gone, plucked away like ears of corn
fully ripe to the realms above. The distinguished lecture
ended with the well-known portion of Holy Writ in the
book of Revelation, "I heard a voice from heaven, saying
unto me, write from henceforth blessed are they that die in

The Oration was then thrown open for discussion, it was at length resolved to form a committee to arrange expenses for printing the oration in pamphlet form both in English and Yoruba. Mr. Akin Adesigba rose to the occasion and offered to print the pamphlets free of cost and his offer was cheered by the audience.

It was a glorious affair. Both English and Yoruba are worthy of the lecturer.
