Ekeji:—*Frank Robert Stephen Jamison. On or about the 24th day of November, 1924, at Lagos, with intent to compel one Pauline Judd to do an act which she was lawfully entitled to abstain from doing, to wit to leave her husband Frederick Judd and live with him the said Frank Robert Stephen Jamison, threatened the said Pauline Judd with injury to her reputation or to that of her said husband. c.c. sec. 306.*

(3) OSENI AJOSE

On or about the 12th day of November 1924, at Lagos. (1) *Stole from a lighter fifteen bags of Cocoa the property of Messrs Elder Dempster & Company c.c. sec 390 (4) (c).*

Sir,

Have you any reason or reasons to give me as motive or motives for your Editorial of last Saturday in which you highly stigmatised the *Lagos Weekly Record* for its special edition of the 2nd of May 1925.

I observe that you have attempted to discourage a mass of readers of the *Record* and charge also the *Record* and other Leaders for being responsible for the present *Eko* position and that some people are making a trade of the readers.

While waiting for your explanations, I have reasons to disclose the facts that you have made a sudden shift.

What were your own comments over the issue of the *Lagos Weekly Record* of the 20th January, 1923, and what was your own Editorial on the refusal by Government of the Monster Petition at the time.

Did you mean to make a trade of readers when you placarded Notices calling upon people to book for special issues of your paper in connection with the Mohammedan Case.

Did you send any part of the proceeds of the sale of that Special Edition to the Seriki of the Muslims, or to the Secretary of the Jamat or to the Imam Ligali.

It is a common knowledge that there are two different camps in Lagos with two different opinions to the House of Docemo. One camp to which the Editor of the *Lagos Weekly Record* and his Associates belonged was the one clamouring for years that Government should extend better treatment to the community and its Prince, the other camp was one opposing continually the interests of the community and its Prince.

To what camp did you belong?

You ought to know that majority of people bought your papers for the purpose of enjoying *Alari-Ajanaku*, his well-arranged Yoruba and English phrases, and also of course, your editorial in decent Yoruba terms when fighting the cause of the community and its Prince, but chiefly for the articles by *Alari-Ajanaku* and *Ahirimann*.

Shorn of those correspondents, *Eko Akete* is useless.

What sort of assistance have you rendered yourself financially or otherwise to the Prince *Eleko*.

In what way were the *Lagos Weekly Record* and its correspondents responsible for the present *Eko* position?

What label do you attach to the opposers?
