SECRETARY OF STATE, LONDON, TO GOVERNOR, LAGOS
DATED 20TH OCTOBER, 1924

20th October. His Majesty has approved arrangement for observance in this country Armistice Day November 11th. (1) Short Service will be held at Cenotaph on the lines adopted in the previous year singing Hymn "O God our help in ages past." His Majesty King will be present and will lay a wreath (2) 2 minutes' silence will be observed at 11 AM (3) Authorities in this country will be asked to arrange suspension of all vehicular traffic for two minutes at 11 AM, but rail and water transport will not be suspended.

I propose to lay wreath on behalf of the Colonies Proterectorates.

MAXIMS—AND COUNTER-MAXIMS.

A saw cuts in one direction, so does the maxim. The axiom, or adage, or proverb, is a half-truth which, to some, truly pregnant, needs to be wedded to its complement; and, like a happy married pair, each so wise, so true, so beautiful, that we can scarcely tell both in the bitter half. Maxims are like lawyers who best needs we told one side of a case. They disregard half evidence, and formulate their prosecution or defence in single crisp sentence. "He who betrieves is lost," says it. "Look before you leap," says the other.

We need but produce a short list of contradictory saws in order to prove our point. Pairing them, we see how difficult it is to derive wisdom from knowledge. A man is known by the company he keeps.

Appearances are deceitful.

Honesty is the best policy.

The truth is not to be spoken at all times.

Too many cooks spoil the broth.

In a multitude of counsellors there is wisdom.

Out of sight, out of mind.

Absence makes the heart grow fonder.

A rolling stone gathers no moss.

A sitting hen never grows fat.

Strike while the iron is hot.

A patient waiter is no loser.

The early bird catches the worm.

There are as good fish in the sea as ever were caught.

It never rains but it pours.

Every cloud has a silver lining.

One swallow does not make a summer.

A straw shows which way the wind blows.

Tis a long time now that no turning.

Tis never too late to mend.

Poverty makes strange bedfellows.

Birds of a feather flock together.

The gods live nits to those that have no teeth.

God tempers the wind to the shorn lamb.

Truth is seen that truth is too elusive, too elastic, to be apprehended into a single sentence. To sail directly to portward we must beat back and forth from one approach to another. The connection of truth is definite and therefore definable is misleading. Truth is an abstraction, a hypothesis, and as impossible to conceive as is the mathematical hypothesis of infinity.

The nearest approach we can make to infinity is by means of series, increasing indefinitely. Yet infinity according to geometry is itself trouble to no different orders of greatness. The infinite lies inside the parabola is less than the infinite lies outside the same curve. Nevertheless the formula of the parabola means of describing its shape, though its direct statement is false.

Stulti, matins, adages, proverbs have their place, for they are little sermons. They have stood the test of time and experience as living vehicles whereby to convey advice, instruction, and counsel in certain emergencies to one, present, and future generations. For—

—The people's voice the voice of God we call;

—And what are proverbs but the people's voice?

Coined first, and current made by common choice, in order to conserve for youth the experience of mankind. Then save they must have weight and truth weight;—

More over, as we must have our blocks from which to build our little houses, so we must have our precepts from blocks to construct our philosophies. Some of the roads of life must be compassed into maxims and proverbs that bind men need to have empirical rules, but they must learn to exceptions themselves, and if it is not until they have done that they find the fulness of attempting to formulate life

and conduct into any "definite code. We teach them the primary colours; but they must find their own purple in the landscape, and think of it, too, as purple, rather than as a combination of blue and red.

Another amplification of the adage is the essay; and even this can scarcely do more than suggest. When the essay attempts to assert, the opposite situation springs up, and challenges our attention, as red, too long situated, induces a sensation of green. The function of the essay is rather to suggest, to indicate a new point of view; and, whether it conveys its message to this fresh way of looking at things, or confirms him in his old opinion, matters little if he it has made him think. The essay should be consolative rather than the disconsolate; its function being to inspire our imaginations.

Maxims pave the way for thought; and, on them we go faster and faster, though we go only on the beaten track. Like bigots, they prevent only a fixed of a truth. Yet without challenges our attention, as red, too long situated, induces the world would not progress at all; for these, possessed of but one side of a truth, flourish their saws and precepts as weapons and braw a way for us. Through affirmation and denial we make a zigzag towards return.

Push on one pedal of your bicycle, and the other comes up to your foot ready for its impulse. So, alternating, we go forward with never a stroke cleanly driven in the true direction we wish to take. Maxims and countermaxims, theory and converse, pugnacious and concordant, rule and exception, orthodoxy and heterodoxy, appeal in turn, and each couple opposite, paired, does not make zero, like positive and negative terms, but a mechanical couple ensuring rotation. Both are true; both are false.

Still, we go progress. We are like points on the rim of a wheel, thinking that, while we are rising and falling, so making and unmaking our adage, we are merely revolving in futile rotation. Instead, we are all carried forward in a secret curve of beauty, the beautiful arch of the cycloid.
