THE Annual Report on the Government Printing Department for 1924 is worth studying by all private Printing Offices in Lagos and Nigeria generally. The quantity of printed matters yearly turned out of this department is simply wonderful. There were 2,970,896 Forms and 302,558 Books printed in 1924, at a cost of £30,000. This is only made possible by the quantity of printing materials which enabled the department to keep 1952 Forms standing without interfering with the other jobs numbering 742 in 1924.

It would be a happy day for us in Nigeria when we can combine to put up such large industrial establishments to be worked on co-operative basis.

We congratulate the Government Printer and staff for the smooth working of the department.

The Annual Report by the Police Magistrates for 1924 is very interesting from many points of view. It reveals the fact that the morality of the people is steadily improving and that crime is becoming less prevalent at Lagos and Calabar.

The slight increase at Ebute-metta was we are glad to note, due to numerous prosecutions under the Town Council Regulations and not criminal proceedings. It shows the settled state of the country and the influence of education in the life
