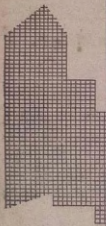

WHEREAS there was this day read at the Board a Report from the Judicial Committee of the Privy Council dated the 19th day of June, 1928 in the words following viz:—

"WHEREAS by virtue of His late Majesty King Edward the Seventh's Order in Council of the 18th day of October 1909 there was referred unto this Committee the matter of an Appeal from the Supreme Court of Nigeria in the matter of an Order under the hand of the Officer Administering the Government dated the 6th day of August, 1925 and also an Order under the hand of the said Officer and seal of the Colony and Protectorate of Nigeria dated the 8th day of August, 1925 under the Deposed Chiefs Removal Ordinance Chapter 78 concerning one Eshugbayi Eleko between Eshugbayi Eleko Appellant and the Officer administering the Government of Nigeria and the District Officer of Oyo Respondents (Privy Council Appeal No 127 of 1927) and likewise a humble Petition of the Appellant setting forth that on the 4th December 1925 notice was given on behalf of the Appellant that by special leave and Order of the Supreme Court Divisional Court No 2 granted on the 24th November 1925 the Court would be moved on the 8th December, 1925 on behalf of the Appellant then under the control of the Officer administering the Government of Nigeria and in the custody care and keeping of the District Officer of Oyo pursuant to an Order dated the 8th August, 1925 for leave to issue a Writ of Habeas Corpus directed to these Officer at the return thereof to bring the Appellant to the Bar of the Court and for any further Order that the Court might deem fit to make: that an affidavit in support of the application was made by the Appellant: that in the affidavit the Appellant alleged *inter alia* that he had been illegally arrested and deported to Oyo in the Province of Oyo Nigeria and was not permitted or allowed to

leave the confines of Oyo and that he was not a person amenable to the Deposed Chiefs Removal Ordinance Chapter 78 under which the Order of deportation dated the 8th December, 1925 had been made: that the motion came before Tew J. on the 8th December, 1925 when Acting Attorney-General raised a preliminary objection to the motion namely that an exactly similar motion had already been dismissed: by the Court and that therefore the motion could not be maintained; that on the 14th December, 1925 Tew J. gave judgment that in view of a previous refusal of an identical application made in September 1925 he had no power to entertain the motion and that the motion must therefore be dismissed: that the Appellant appealed to the Full Court of the Supreme Court and on the 17th February 1926 that Court ordered that the matter should be remitted to the Court below for an affidavit to be filed by a Law Officer stating that a previous application based on substantially the grounds had been made to the Court in September 1925 and that the preliminary point should be argued and judgment given thereon that the Solicitor-General of Nigeria made an affidavit on the 9th March 1926 and deposed *inter alia* that on the 18th September 1925 an application had been made to the Court on substantially the same grounds as the application of the 4th December 1925 and that the Writ was refused on the 12th October 1925; that the matter came before Tew J. and the motion was dismissed on the 18th March, 1926; that on the 26th April Tew J. gave his reasons for dismissing the motion: that he stated *inter alia* that the grounds for the second application were substantially the same as those on which the first application was based and that he had no jurisdiction to entertain the application: that the Appellant appealed to the Full Court and that Court on the 10th June 1926 affirmed the Judgment of Tew J. upholding the preliminary objection and dismissed the Appeal: that the Appellant applied to the Full Court for leave to appeal to Your Majesty in Council and the application was refused: that the Appellant obtained special leave to appeal to Your Majesty in Council on the 13th May, 1927 upon depositing in the Registry of the Privy Council the sum of £400 as security for costs which condition has been complied with; And humbly praying Your Majesty in Council to take this Appeal into consideration and that the Judgment or Order of the Full Court of the Supreme Court dated the 10th June, 1926 may be reversed altered or varied or for further or other relief.

"THE LORDS OF THE COMMITTEE in obedience to His late Majesty's said Order in Council have taken the Appeal and humble Petition into

consideration and having heard Counsel on behalf of the Parties on both sides Their Lordships do this day agree humbly to report to Your Majesty as their opinion (1) that this Appeal ought to be allowed and Judgment or Order of the Full Court of the Supreme Court of Nigeria dated 10th day of June 1926 and the Judgment or Order of the said Supreme Court dated the 18th day of March 1926 set aside (2) that the case ought to be remitted to the said Supreme Court in order that the Appellant's application to that Court dated the 4th day of December 1925 may be disposed of on the evidence already filed and on any further evidence that may be placed before it (3) that the Registrar of Privy Council ought to be directed to repay to the Appellant the sum of £400 so deposited as aforesaid as security for costs and (4) that there ought to be paid by the Respondents to the Appellant his costs of the Appeal to the said Full Court his costs of this Appeal incurred in the said Supreme Court and the sum of £518. 19. 1 for his costs thereof incurred in England and that the costs of the said application to the said Supreme Court ought to abide the result of the re-hearing thereof by that Court"

HIS MAJESTY having taken the said Report into consideration was pleased by and with the advice of His Privy Council to approve thereof and to order as it is hereby ordered that the same be punctually observed obeyed and carried into execution.

Whereof the Governor or Officer administering the Government of Nigeria for the time being and all other persons whom it may concern are to take notice and govern themselves accordingly

THE DEATH OF THE GREAT EMPIRE
Viscount Haldane of Cloan, O.M., Kt.,
Barrister-at-Law.

It is with deepest regret we chronicle the lamentable death of the late Right Honourable Viscount Richard Burdon Haldane of Cloan, O.M., K.T., B.L., which took place at his residence in Scotland on Sunday the 19th August, 1928.

Lord Haldane was Lord Chancellor of Great Britain from 1912 to 1915; he was Rector of Edinburgh University and Chancellor of the University of Bristol. He was called to the Bar in 1879, and took silk in the year 1890 as Queen's Counsel. His Lordship was a member of the Judicial Committee of the Privy Council where Nigeria came into close contact with him on two distinct and successful occasions, the Appeal of Chief Amodu Tijani Oluwa in the great Apapa Land Case, which he has won in July 11, 1921, and on May 9th 1927, Viscount Haldane with Lord Warrington and Lord Shaw as Lords of the Judicial Committee of the Privy Council advised His Majesty that leave be granted to Prince Eşugbayi Eleko of Lagos, in his Appeal.

The late Lord Haldane's name will always be remembered in the whole British Empire. As a man who maintained Justice, Equity and Fairplay.

His remains were removed to Glenagles, Scotland, on Thursday, the 23rd instant for interment.

The King in a message of sympathy to the relatives says "Lord Haldane will be remembered with respect and gratitude for his service to the state and especially by all who recognised that it was chiefly due to his able administration as War Minister that 14 years ago on the outbreak of hostilities the British Expeditionary Force was promptly and efficiently mobilised and despatched abroad".

May his soul rest in peace.
