A BILL ENTITLED.

An ordinance to Regulate the Levying and collection of A general Tax in the Colony.

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of Nigeria,
with the advice and consent of the Legislative
Council thereof, as follows:—

1. This ordinance may be cited as the General
Tax (Colony)* ordinance 1927, and shall apply
to the Colony only, and shall come into force on
the 1st April, 1928.

2. There shall be Levied and collected, in
manner hereinafter mentioned a tax (hereinafter
called the general Tax") of ten shillings *per annum*
payable by every male person of the age of sixteen
years and upwards resident in the Colony.
