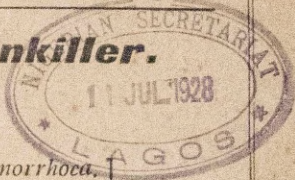

Ede yi li a fere le lo si ẹda-iwe ti a da ni oyinbo ti o mbe ni isalẹ iwe yi nipa Oniṣe-oba kan ti nwon ni o lo hale mo Eleko ni Oyo pe nwon ko ni jeki o wa si Eko mo lailai lenu re lẹhuan. Ẹ gbọ labari yi ti wi:—

We understand that an Official Inquiry is being promptly undertaken with a view to ascertain who and who are responsible for the mischievous move on Thursday last when the District Officer at Oyo and a European Police Officer from Lagos went to Prince Eshugbayi Eleko at his resident in Oyo and there to disturb the innocent Prince's peace, even in exile.

Since Prince Eshugbayi Eleko had been at Oyo on August 8, 1925, the District officer Mr. Reginald Henry Lapage, B.A., has only once paid the Prince a visit, and that was on horseback in May last, when he chatted to Prince Eshugbayi

Eleko over the mud window of his hut, for seven minutes only.

There is a strong presumption that the mischief last week was hatched from Lagos; but we do not desire at this or any later stage of the proceedings to embarrass the higher officials of the Nigerian Government—L. D. N.—25/6/28.

Birrell Gray attended at the Iga Idunganran on Wednesday last,—has suddenly cooled down since the gallant Major's visit to the Iga on Saturday last.

We have not however been favoured with an official denial,—for publication in these columns,—of the rumour we published on Friday last, in justice to the Administrator of this colony.

D. N.—29/6/28.

THE HOUSE OF DOCEMO.

King Dosunmu, who ceded the Island of Lagos, died in 1884, when he was succeeded by his son Oyekan, who died in 1900, and was succeeded in

1901, by Eshugbayi Eleko, another son of king Dosunmu.

In this Extraordinary Gazette there is now published for the first time (1920) a despatch dated 23rd February, 1901, and addressed by the late Sir William Mac Gregor, a former Governor of Lagos, to the Right Honourable Joseph Chamberlain, then His Majesty's Principal Secretary of State for the Colonies—J. F.—P. 5.
