The reason was, it is said that Cke 'Bt. dan objected to the inquisitiveness of the populace in trying to see his eyes (which must not be seen) whenever he walks about the town at night. In course got time this order was limited to the large central market called Ojaba—to the great relief of the people.

For this same reason Oke Badan Day is always observed as a Public Hollday and nobody is allowed to make fire, cook or carry lights about. Even the priest of Oke Badan must not see smokes anywhere on that day.
