rē ko si rigbodiyan larin ilu bi ti aiye Akitoye pelu Koskō, bikoše ibga ti ija nla kan şe larin Qba Dosunmu, Ajasa Apena, Balogun Aşogbon, Taiwo Olowo ati awon elomitan jakantanjakakan, ija na ni nwon ne pi ija Qba Dosunmu ati Taiwo Olowo, awon-agbagba yio ma ranti bi ija na ti le to bi a ti nvi lowo yi.

Qba Dosunmu w' aja, Oyekan akobi rē gun ori oye ninu odata 1885 larin oṣu March, a ko ri ija-igboro tabi ijakija kan ni sanmóni rē debi ti a fi le şo wípe enikan fi ilu silé—şugbón larin Qba rē ni awon Ijôba-İgesi pelu awon ara Ijebu-Ode, Gomina G. T. Carter, K.C.M.G., lo mbé nihin nigbana.

Ni gbogbo asekó awon Qba ti a ka fun nyin yi, eyiti o ti béré lori Qba Adó ni odata 1630, dajudaju a koi ti fi ighbakan gbo ri, bëni nwon ko fi şorç so fun wa ri pe awon Idéjo kan Ogalade tabi Abagbón dide ni arin ile yi mu oña kan pö penwón nije fají ló si ibikibi, lajje wípe o han fun gbogbo ilu ri, bi irufé ohun bë tilé han fun ilu mò lasi tabi tabi ati iyapa ènu, ambòsì-bòsì ohun ti a kó ti ti ni ilu yi arara.

#### Serious Earthquake in Turkey.

##### CASUALTIES IN SMYRNA.

Our Constantinople Correspondent telegraphs:—

There was a serious earthquake in Western Turkey between 2.05 and 2.30 on Saturday morning. The shocks were most severely felt in Smyrna, but disturbances were also felt at places so far apart as Konia and Adrianople. About 20 different shocks were felt in Smyrna, where there has been loss of life and considerable damage to property. According to the latest information 21 persons have been killed and more than 60 injured. Thirty houses and two shops have been completely destroyed; six Mosques, many public buildings, and several hundred houses and shops damaged, and the picturesque clock tower seriously damaged. The worst damage appears to have been done at the Village of Torbali, close to Smyrna. *The Times Weekly Edition*. 5/4/28.
