

IFE NEWS.

A regrettable incident occurred at Ile Ife sometime in March last, by the suspension for 3 months of Lówa one of the inner Chiefs of that country from his seat as one of the Judges in the Native Court for an intolerable attitude towards the Paramount Chief, the Oni of Ife.

It would appear that this Chief thought he could do as he liked before the Oni at the palace regardless of native customs and usages and the iron hand with which the senior Resident Captain W. A. Ross is supporting Native Administration generally on any matter which is not at variance with justice, equity and fairplay, with the result that he the Chief finds himself in his unfortunate plight.

That Chief Lówa had been displaying for sometime past an insolent tendency towards the Oni cannot be gainsaid, and his evil example in this respect has apparently contaminated some members of his household including one of his own children who had the audacity recently to assault, in a public street at Ile, Prince Adeyemi of that town without provocation, as a result of

which the aggressor was convicted and sentenced to imprisonment at Ibadan.

Prior to the advent of British Flag—a flag of freedom and happiness in our country—the penalty attached to a crime assaulting a Prince and Heir to a reigning King was death by torture; and Chief Lówa's son should congratulate himself after the assault for his continued existence, rendered possible only by the Union Jack.

It is understood that Captain Ross took a serious view of the incident especially because so the report goes, of Chief Lówa's failure to do what was necessary in the matter immediately after his son had committed such a serious crime.

BURGLARS AT ILE IFE.

Most disquieting news of burglaries at Ife have reached us lately and among the shops looted was that of Prince Adeyemi's where goods to the value of about £250 were done away with. Since the beginning of this year, the activities of burglars in the town were becoming alarming and the most unfortunate of it all is that no one has been able to bring a single member of the daring fraternity to book up till now.

While it may be idle to suspect any person or persons, it is a melancholy fact that the presence in a large number of Hausas and Sabarumos synchronizes with Burglarious activities and nocturnal expeditions in town. Our sympathy goes to Prince Adeyemi and other sufferers in this respect. My God reward the loss and expose the thieves.

THE CONVICTION OF MR. ADEREMI OF IFE.

Another news of an astounding character relates to the conviction of one Aderemí of Ife who was sentenced to a fine of £25 or 6 months imprisonment for posing and styling himself "Qba l'ola" meaning "Future King" who will succeed the present holder of the office.

At first, people thought Aderemí merely indulged himself in idle jokes, and when he was carrying the joke too far, it was necessary to call a halt. On one occasion he actually went the length of seating in a motor car with a big Umbrella resembling the state one in shades and design over his head, with host of people, labouring under a mis-apprehension, acclaining him a King and paying him respects and homage befitting the dignity and position of the Oni.

The fury of the whole community to realize subsequently that it was Aderemí who was impersonating the King could better be imagined than describable, and since that time Aderemí has fallen from grace to grass in the estimation of the people. A climax was reached which culminated in his prosecution before the Council Court,

Ifé, on Tuesday, 8th March, 1928, when he pleaded guilty and convicted on Saturday two days afterwards,

It is stated that Aderemi claims or pretends to be a son of Kóla the late Oni (3) who "reigned" for 30 days at Ifé prior to the ascension of the present Oni to the throne. No less than 3 of Kóla's antecedents had been chosen to rule and died before being crowned, a deplorable fact which according to the decision of the Elders of those days, has constituted a disability on their unfortunate house forbidding any of its members from occupying the unique position of the Oni. This is the family to which Aderemi is said to have claimed a relationship which in itself is bad enough. But worse still, when it is suggested as has been done by those whose knowledge of affairs at Ifé Ife cannot be ignored that Aderemi has not a particle of royal blood in his veins—he being according to their story, a son of a commoner named Kébè native of Mòdakéké. Anyhow, it is alleged that Aderemi has succeeded to include in the Royal Geological table of Ifé as far back as 1924, if so, the Table needs revision. The question ought to be settled once for all one way or the other to avoid future trouble and unpleasantness.

We congratulate the Oti and Council of Ife for the leniency displayed by the imposition of only a nominal fine of £25 for such a serious breach of discipline, foolish pretension and gross insolence on the part of Aderemi and admire both Prince Adeyemi's and his cousin Coker's charity in exercising their combined influence in favour of Aderemi, otherwise something more serious would have happened to him.
