

WEST AFRICANS IN LONDON EXAMINATIONS.

Mr. I. Asafu Adjaye (Gold Coast) passed in the junior clinical surgical examination held last month, being placed third in the First Class Division in a list issued on October 11 by University College Hospital. Mr. Ansah Obuadabang Larbi, inter B.A. (London), of the Gold Coast, passed in the external intermediate examination in laws, LL.B., held at the University of London, South Kensington, on September 24, 25 and 26. The result was announced on October 12. Mr. R. O. Staveley (junr.), of Lagos, has passed in the matriculation (full) examination of the University of London held in September. Mr. Staveley is a second year engineering student at the day technical college, Battersea Polytechnic. By passing this examination in the necessary subject for exemption, he has qualified for an exemption from the A.M.I.C.E. preliminary. He is to take the inter science examination shortly.

PRIVY COUNCIL CASES FROM THE COAST.

Two West African appeals are to be heard in the Michaelmas sittings of the Privy Council, which opened last Monday. The first is that of Kwest Bediaku against Akcsua Mianoo, an appeal from the Gold Coast Colony, relating to a claim to land and the regularity of certain proceedings. The solicitor are, for the appellant, Messrs. Ashurst, Morris, Crisp and Co.; and for the respondents, Messrs. Holmes, Son and Pott. The other appeal comes from Nigeria and is that of Zizer against the Judges of the Supreme Court of Nigeria, raising the question whether the appellant was rightly suspended from practising as a barrister or solicitor. Mr. E. F. Hunt is instructing for the appellant and Messrs. Burchells are solicitors for the respondents.

TEXT BOOK COMMITTEE.

The Text-book Committee has held quarterly meetings throughout the year.

Although it cannot be claimed that as yet much has been actually achieved, a considerable amount

of spadework has been done, and materials are being collected and prepared which should be of value in the future.

The Rev. F. W. Dodds, Superintendent of the Primitive Methodist Mission, and the Rev. G. Burton, Principal of St. Andrew's College, Ojo, have been making collections of Ibo and Yoruba folklore stories respectively. Many of the stories are very picturesque. In these Nigerian folklore stories it is almost invariably the tortoise who plays the part of 'Brer Rabbit' in the Uncle Remus stories and triumphs by his cunning. The present intention is to publish a selection of these stories in the principal vernaculars.

Publication in Yoruba does not present much difficulty, but publication in Ibo will. At the request of the Text-book Committee, a Sub-Committee was formed to enquire into the question of "Union Ibo," which has been formed from the different dialects and is an attempt to standardise the language. It is claimed that Union Ibo is now understood and used over a wide and increasing area in the Ibo Provinces. The Sub-Committee reported in favour of Union Ibo, but advised that the existing vocabulary, which had been originally formed for the purpose of translating the Bible, needed considerable amplification and improvement. It is hoped that during 1928 it will be possible to second for this purpose an officer of the department, who will collaborate with members of the Missions and others who have an extensive knowledge of the language. It is doubtful whether much headway can be made with the publication of books in Ibo till this necessary work has been completed.

The manuscript of a book on the teaching of English has been sent to England for final revision and publication.

Collections of Ibo and Yoruba songs and airs are being made, and a member of the Committee, the Rev. E. G. Nightingale, has undertaken the preparation of a book on African children's games.

Arrangements have been made for the publication of a Yoruba Reader by Mrs. G. W. Sadler of the American Baptist Mission.

A Duala Grammar by Mr. E. A. L. Gaskin, Superintendent of Education, which it is hoped will be of considerable assistance to officers posted to the Cameroons Province, has been published.

A book entitled 'Plant and Animal Life in Tropical Africa' has been written by Mrs. Anislie in collaboration with her husband, Mr. J. R.

Anislie, Senior Conservator of Forests. This book which has been illustrated, is now in the

press, and will shortly be published. In the opinion of members of the Text-book Committee to whom the manuscript was submitted, it is admirably suited for children in the higher standards.

The members of the Text-book Committee during the year were the Director of Education, the Deputy Director of Education, the Principal of King's College, Sister Agathon, Roman Catholic Mission, Rev. G. Burton Principal of St. Andrew's College, Oyo, Church Missionary Society, Mr. Henry Car, I.S.O., the Rev. F. W. Dodds, Primitive Methodist Mission, Mr. Evan B. Jones, United Free Church Mission, the Rev. E. G. Nightingale, Principal of Wesley College, Ibadan, the Rev. G. W. Sadler, American Baptist Mission, and Mr. C. W. Wakeman, C. M. S. Bookshop, Lagos. During the absence on leave of the Rev. G. W. Sadler and the Rev. E. G. Nightingale, Miss Reagan, of the American Baptist Mission, and the Rev. J. A. Angus, Principal of the Wesleyan Boy's High School, served on the Committee.

THE RETIRING ARCHBISHOP OF CANTERBURY.

Presentation at Lambeth Palace.

London, Tuesday.

At a private ceremony at Lambeth Palace, Mr. Baldwin, the Prime Minister presented the retiring Archbishop of Canterbury with £14,000 collected from at least 15,000 subscribers in response to the invitation of a committee consisting of the Archbishop of York, the Prime Minister, the Earl of Selborne, Lord Dunedin, the Marchioness of Salisbury, the Dean of Westminster, Sir Thomas Inskip and the Rev. Scott Lidgett.

The total amount subscribed was £16,936, of which £200 is devoted to a memorial at Lambeth Palace to commemorate Dr. Davidson's association with the place. Another presentation will be made by the Bishop of Western New York and President of Trinity College Harford on behalf of the American Church. It will be in form of an address signed on behalf of the House of Bishops and the House of Clerical and Lay Deputies

accompanied by a draft of 10,000 dollars in a gold casket—*Reuter*.
