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



THE WESLEYAN SYNOD.

(Continued from our last.)

On Wednesday and Friday, the closing Sessions of the Wesleyan Methodist Synod took place. Much of the business was of a routine character and of little general interest. Such exhorters as the attitude to be adopted towards unauthorised societies loosely connected with our Church, terms of admission of members of other Churches to the Wesleyan Methodist Church, and of Wesleyan Methodist Members of other Churches were discussed. Probationers studies for the coming year were arranged and returns were presented in order to enable the Secretary to complete his schedules.

Many years ago during a time of spiritual depression, the Conference which met at Liverpool adopted certain resolutions upon the duties of Wesleyan Methodist Ministers. Since then it has been the custom to read these resolutions, which are familiarly known as the "Liverpool Minutes" at each Annual Synod, throughout the Methodist Church, and to follow the reading with what is called "The Conversation on the work of God." This is always a time of great heart-searching and the present occasion was no exception to the rule. The remainder of Wednesday's session was devoted to the observance of this practice and the "Conversation" was particularly helpful and inspiring. At the close the brethren joined in the Hymn "Lord in the strength of Grace" after which the Synod was adjourned until Friday in order to allow time for the preparation of the minutes.

On Friday, the Synod reassembled and received those of the Stationing Committee. The following are the changes which have been made. Rev. J. C. Cole is transferred the Staff of Wesley College, Indian, Rev. D. A. Beck goes to Ago, (Ijebu Mission,) Rev. B. A. Sababu Ebute-Metta, and Rev. S. A. Pearce to Oban Eko, newly received probationer, Rev. E. Ajayi Cole is appointed to work in the Ijebu Circuit, where we stand he will be in charge of a flourishing C. I. M. I. I. P. A.

It was intimated that the Missionary Collections amounted to £25 and it was agreed to divide this between the Opobo, Igbo-Ijebu and Ijebu work.

The minutes of the Synod were then read and signed and according to immemorial custom the Synod came to a close with the singing of the hymn.


